## Driving Directions in Seattle

1. From I-5 take S.R. 520 towards Bellevue.
2. In ¾ mile get off 520 at Montlake.
3. Turn left at light onto Montlake Boulevard.
4. Go straight through three lights (Hamlin, Shelby, Pacific) and pass Husky Stadium.
5. Get into the left lane. At the fork, keep straight onto 25<sup>th</sup> while Montlake veers right.
6. Immediately turn left at the next light onto the UW Campus, at Pend Oreille Drive.
7. If the parking kiosk is open, pay \$7.00 fee.
8. At top of hill, turn left onto Stevens Way.
9. The University of Washington Club is the third building on the left; take the steep driveway just before the building. If parking spaces behind the facility are full, retrace route and park behind Padelford Hall, on the right just before the parking kiosk.
